Gulbalanha: know and understand each other

Year 5 and 6 final images of their artworks that were displayed at Wagga Wagga Regional Gallery through the exhibition *Gulbalanha: know and understand each other.* Students will receive their artworks back this week.





We would like to acknowledge that we are in Wradjun Country, and recognise the Wradjun people as the traditional owners of this land. We would also like to pay respect to the Elders both past and present of the Wradjun Nation and an expect of the Community members.

Outbalanha: knew and understand each ether is the second iteration of the successful partnership between Wagga Wagga Art. Gallery, the Art Gallery of New South Wales and the Department of Education. Gubbalanha demonstrates how the use of well-established collections can provide an incovative and rich means of reaching out into educational communities, as well as extending the traditional exhibition focus of galleries.

Fourteen schools engaged in the program throughout 2016, Ardiethan Central School, Bairanald Central School, Finley Public School, Oundagai Public School, Hume Public School, Mapoola Public School, Loewsdale Public School, Loewsdale Public School, Tambar Public School, Tumut Public School, Tumparumba Public School, Uranquinty Public School and Watla Walla Valla Valla

As part of the embedded program taught in their school environments, students also made their way to Wagga Wagga for hands on printmaking utilising the wonderful work of Roy Kennedy and HJ Wedge as inspiration. There was lots of voiced amazement as students revealed their prints for the first time. Lively participation tools place in the parallel groups practising their Wradjuri language with Lettile Harris and guest tutors. Ruth Dacey-Davys and Dr Pettina Love.

Wagga Wagga Art Gallery are very fortunate to have access to community groups, artists, and elders who have assisted in providing the resources and support for Gulbalanha. The program has been enriched by their input and participation. Importantly the dedication from Wiradjuri community members, who so willingly give their time for many programs, is deeply appreciated.
