We would like to acknowledge that we are in Wiradjuri Country, and recognise the Wiradjuri people as the traditional owners of this land. We would also like to pay respect to the Elders both past and present of the Wiradjuri Nation and extend that respect to all community members.

Gulbalanha: know and understand each other is the second iteration of the successful partnership between Wagga Wagga Art Gallery, the Art Gallery of New South Wales and the Department of Education. ***Gulbalanha*** demonstrates how the use of well-established collections can provide an innovative and rich means of reaching out into educational communities, as well as extending the traditional exhibition focus of galleries.

Fourteen schools engaged in the program throughout 2016, Ardethan Central School, Balranald Central School, Finley Public School, Gundagai Public School, Hume Public School, Kapooka Public School, Lockhart Central School, Lowesdale Public School, Rand /Burumbuttock Public School, Talbingo Public School, Tumut Public School, Tumbarumba Public School, Urangundy Public School and Walla Walla Public School. Importantly, in this exhibition, the year long journey made by the collective of participating students and teachers is visually and metaphorically acknowledged and chronicled.

As part of the embedded program taught in their school environments, students also made their way to Wagga Wagga for hands on printmaking

utilising the wonderful work of Roy Kennedy and H.J. Wedge as inspiration. There was lots of voiced amazement as students revealed their prints for the first time. Lively participation took place in the parallel groups practising their Wiradjuri language with Letitia Harris and guest tutors Ruth Dacey-Davys and Dr Pettina Love.

Wagga Wagga Art Gallery are very fortunate to have access to community groups, artists and elders who have assisted in providing the resources and support for ***Gulbalanha***. The program has been enriched by their input and participation. Importantly the dedication from Wiradjuri community members, who so willingly give their time for many programs, is deeply appreciated.
